PUBLIC NOTICE BY IOWA PORK PRODUCERS ASSOCIATION AND THE NATIONAL PORK BOARD


The election of pork producer delegate candidates for the 2025 National Pork Producers (Pork Act) Delegate Body will be conducted electronically from June 4, 10:00 am through June 11, 2024 at 12:00 pm Noon by going to the following link <u>https://www.iowapork.org/porkactdelegateelection/</u>. After submitting the electronic ballot, a "Thank You for Voting" message will be displayed to confirm the electronic vote was successful.

All Iowa pork producers are invited to participate.

In-person voting (written ballot) will not be conducted.

Any producer age 18 or older who is a resident of Iowa and has paid all assessments due may be considered as a delegate candidate and/or participate in the election. All eligible producers are encouraged to bring with them a sales receipt proving that hogs were sold in their name and the checkoff deducted. 
MY FAMILY'S DAIRY FARM
